Aventor reveals «The race for energy efficiency»

at Auto Zurich Car Show

Integrated into the 'CE & Mobility trends' stand, the electric monoplace built in La Neuveville will make the show from Thursday 10th to Sunday 13th of November, at Auto Zurich Car Show.

Aventor is an innovative concept of electric mobility oriented towards competitions and city races.

Fully recyclable, Aventor is made of an organic polymer body with aluminum frame inside. The car only weighs 420kg, battery included. Aventor offers various configurations, "Trikes" 3 wheelers or "monoplace" 4 wheelers with torque from 400 to 900 Nm and power between 30 and 160 kW (40 to 217 HP).

A «Trike» version participated in the first electric Grand Prix organized in 2014 for the 'Lignières historique' event with 7 times side-car world champion Rolf Biland.

This summer of 2016, the swiss rallye champion Nicolas Althaus led our 3 wheeler trike with power and drifts in the St-Ursanne - Les rangiers hill climb race, part of the european mountain FIA championship.



Focused on the future, Aventor adorn a 4th wheel, becoming the ultimate car for alternative motor competitions.

Among the future challenges signed Aventor, Jean-Luc Thuliez CEO of the company, believes that this type of electric propulsion vehicle will inevitably win in hill climbs, starting with the electrical category at "Les Rangiers" in August 2017.

Next year, Twenty Aventor cars shall dispute a race on the street circuit of Victoria Harbour in Hong Kong and will participate in an Asian championship in 2018.
